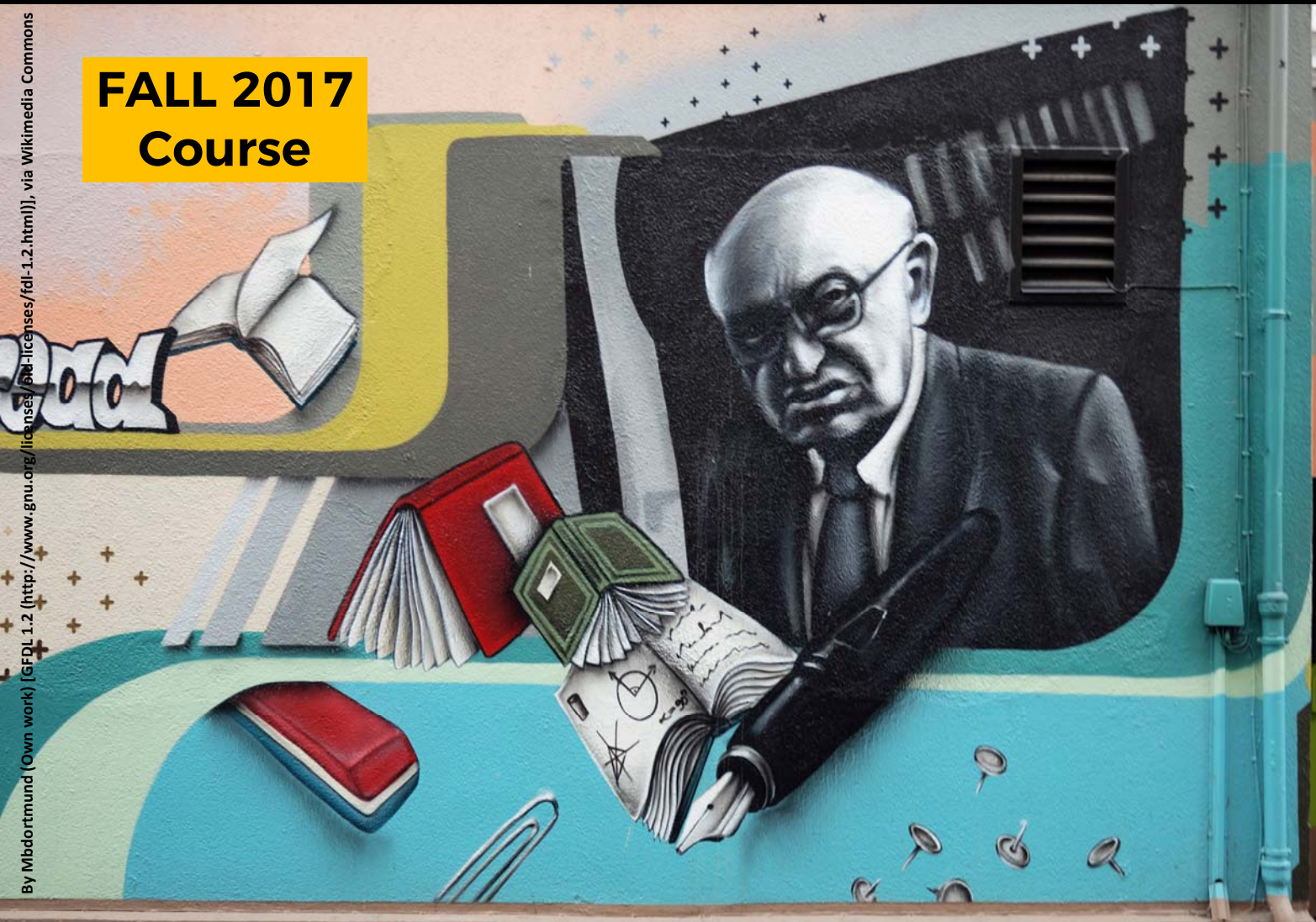

Marcel Reich-Ranicki, the most famous literary critic in Germany after 1945, wrote haunting pieces about German literary history from the middle ages until present. His collected portraits of classical writers such as Gotthold Ephraim Lessing, Johann Wolfgang von Goethe, Friedrich Schiller and Friedrich Hölderlin are perfect readings for an introduction to German literary history. This course provides you not only with the most important knowledge about the key stations in German poetry and culture, but allows us to analyze popular forms of the transmission of literature in modern media.
