Number of Awards: One

- Applicants must enroll (or intend to enroll) in an approved University of Calgary study abroad program of at least six weeks at an accredited German-speaking university during the upcoming year
- The scholarship is offered annually to a continuing undergraduate student enrolled in the Faculty of Arts, BA or BA Honours program, majoring in German, or in Linguistics and Languages with concentration in German.
 - Should there be no eligible student in these majors, selection of a student with a German minor is permitted.
 - Should there be no eligible student with a German major or minor, a student who has completed three half courses equivalent to senior-level German courses will be considered
- Overall minimum GPA of 2.60 in Fall 2017/Winter 2018; minimum of 24 units
- Applicants must submit a personal statement on how the study experience in a German-speaking country will assist their future plans
